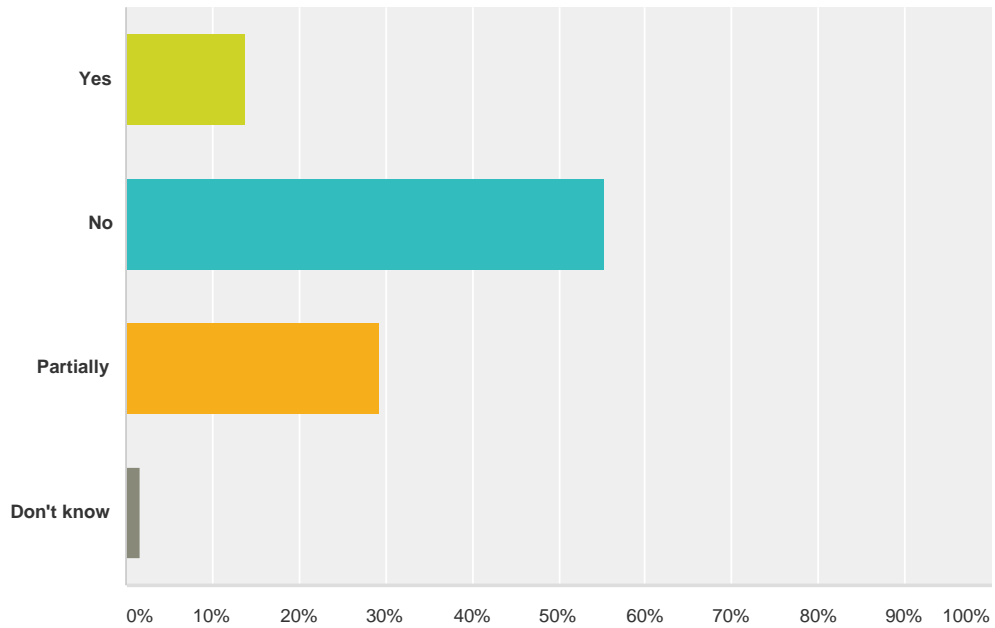


Q2 Does the business continuity team in your organization manage information security threats?

#	Please briefly describe how your organization structures its information security management:
1	Separate Information Security Team
2	It sits within the IT department. There are three IT security specialists in London and a global security team. I meet with them monthly.
3	However the information security team does review the controls (additional) that may be placed from the recovery location.
4	Private.
5	As completely separate vaguely related to security but not embedded.
6	Continuity Team is part of Info Security, but we have a Tech and Data Loss Teams that deal directly with IT division and threats.
7	GM Infosec reports to COO
8	Not direct management but they would be notified if there was a security breach.
9	IS is a unit within our Information Technology organization reporting directly to the CIO
10	There is a Cyber Incident Response team. The BC Team is just a role on that team.
11	Separate department
12	Only when it becomes an incident (such as a data breach) but not part of the daily monitoring of threats
13	Business is not large enough to warrant "teams"

Business continuity and information security

14	Information security have prime responsibility for data security, but must ensure BC arrangements comply.
15	BCM team is part of CISO office. Many more People work with info sec.
16	We have a separate InfoSec team who manage the threats. BC and DR work closely with them to plan the responses should their defences fail.
17	Managed by dedicated, trained resource,
18	BCM Coordinator is tied into the corporate IT so that we are aware when threats materialize
19	Information security and business continuity are components of a wider business operations governance team
20	The BC teams works with the Information Security Team
21	they are collaborative but one does not rule the other when it should.
22	BC Team is one person. Very close cooperation with Information security
23	Still separate and distinct, with very little interaction across the wall.
24	BCP works closely with InfoSec but does not manage security threats. BCP does consider InfoSec a threat scenario.
25	Business continuity and Information security are part of the same Group Security function and collaborate accordingly.
26	Information Security sits within our Technology operations but does form part of our organisational resilience.
27	business continuity is part of information security.
28	Information Security is at early stages.
29	Information Security Management is managed within IT.
30	it is an IT department responsibility
31	We are part of the CERT.
32	BCPO would be involved in escalating the incident to the appropriate level and would then take a back seat facilitation role to keep the rest of the organization informed as to the incident and the appropriate response while at the same time not interfering with the InfoSec professionals
33	We're part of the same team. I have responsibilities in both processes.
34	Separate Info Sec team and IT Security team, though work together closely.
35	BC & InfoSec separated
